NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i), Plaintiffs hereby dismiss the instant action. On Friday, July 24, 2020, Counsel for Defendants notified Plaintiffs that Defendant U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) had completed naturalizations for named Plaintiffs and 2,202 members of the putative class defined in Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification. Counsel for Defendants further indicated that USCIS scheduled approximately 12 members of the putative class for oath ceremonies in June and July, but those individuals asked to have their oath ceremonies rescheduled. Accordingly, as all named Plaintiffs and putative class members either have naturalized or had the opportunity to do so, the issues outlined in Plaintiffs' Complaint are resolved, and Counsel for Plaintiffs submit this notice of dismissal.
